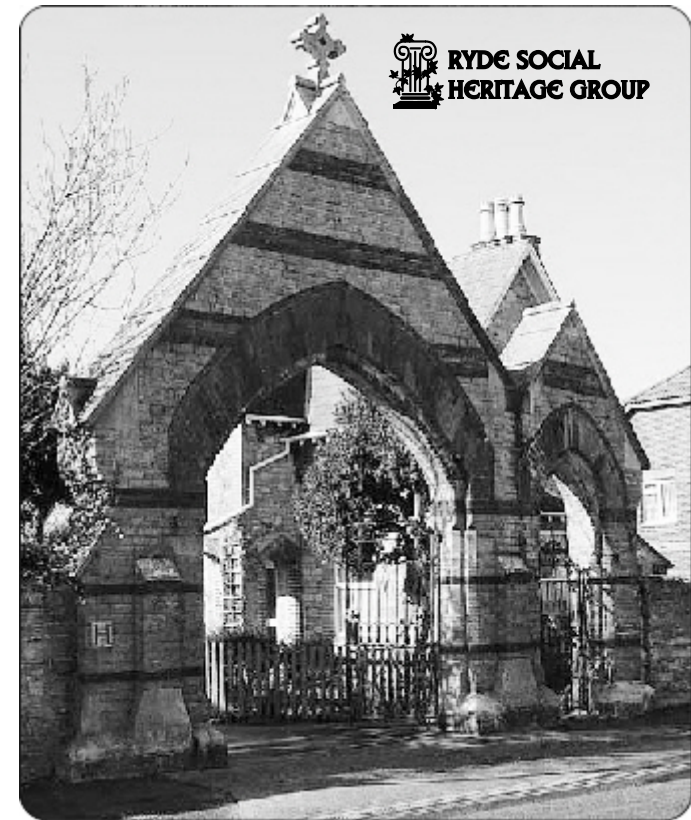


Ryde Cemetery Plan

INFORMATION COMMUNICATION TECHNOLOGY

ICT is incorporated in all areas of study. The Heritage Learning Centre has a fully equipped Computer Suite with Internet access, also DVD, a projector and screen. In follow up sessions back at school children can produce text and graphic work, including Powerpoint presentations, do further Internet research and work on Databases etc.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

PE links have already been mentioned under the Geography section as the children are undertaking fieldwork investigation, following directions, using maps, planning routes which incorporates outdoor and adventurous activities and orienteering skills within the PE curriculum.
